BUS

Reserve your seat(s) on the buses traveling to Annapolis when you RSVP for the reception.

Buses will depart Poly/Western High School parking lot promptly at 4:45 p.m. and will depart Annapolis promptly at 8:15 p.m. to return to Baltimore.

DIRECTIONS

From Baltimore:

- Take I-695 to Glen Burnie / Annapolis
- Stay to the left and follow I-97 to Annapolis/Bay Bridge
- I-97 becomes US 50 E
- Continue on US 50 E to Exit 24 – Historic Annapolis/Rowe Blvd
- Keep to the right on the ramp and follow Rowe Blvd. into Annapolis

OR

Take 895 S (Harbor Tunnel) to Annapolis/Glen Burnie Exit.
Follow directions above after bearing right onto I-97 (Annapolis).

PARKING

Calvert Street Garage: Free public parking is available after 6pm in the Calvert Street Garage, located at the corner of Bladen Street and Calvert Street.

Navy/Marine Corps Stadium: Parking is available at the Navy/Marine Corps Stadium for \$5 a day. Take Rowe Blvd and turn right onto Taylor Avenue. Enter at Gate 5. The shuttle runs every 15 to 20 minutes until 10:00 PM.

Gott's Court Garage: 25 Northwest Street (attached to the Annapolis Visitor's Center) From Rowe Blvd. follow signs for "Visitor Center Parking" which will lead you into the Gotts Court parking garage. When exiting the garage, turn right towards Church Circle. Turn left at the circle and walk one block to Bladen Street. Turn left on Bladen St. and continue to the entrance of the Lowe House Office Building.

There may be parking in the residential areas around the complex, but the 2-hour parking limit is strictly enforced.
